
NSW GC Pennants Competition 2020

In recent years there has been increased frequency of members bringing guests to play at the Club. The Committee has reviewed the situation and will shortly be circulating club policy on this issue.

Guests must <u>always</u> sign the Attendance Book and state that they have paid \$10 per person (or \$5 each if belonging to another croquet club). Lawn bookings are not required, unless you are holding a function booked with the Secretary.

If you have friends or relatives who are coming to play repeatedly, they should be asked to join the Club. Application Forms are available in the Clubhouse, just near the Mallet Room.

Coronavirus Prevention

In recent weeks, the Club has circulated updates on measures to avoid coronavirus. We are following advice from Croquet NSW and from NSW Department of Health – as well as Government requirements.

We are fortunate to still be able to use our club for outdoor games, taking care to always be more than **1.5 metres away** from others. Please ensure you wash your hands thoroughly before and after touching anything at the Club. Use paper towel to dry hands.

The Club has provided **disposable drinking vessels**, for your extra protection. Do NOT leave rinsed glasses and mugs draining in the sink.

DO NOT COME to the Club if you have been exposed to high risk persons, OR if you have any symptoms of cold or flu.

We hope we can continue to keep our Club open for outdoor activities for the duration of this epidemic.
