# **COVID CHANGES for Mosman Croquet**

Following increases in COVID-19 in NSW over the last month, the Chief Health Officer has asked for **greater restrictions** in community sport, to reduce risk of disease transmission.

- The Mosman Bash 2020 (4-6 Sept) is cancelled
- Non-croquet activities need to stop for the time being: 'Turn Up, Participate, Leave'.
  This means no Bridge/Mahjong; no group morning teas, drinks, etc.

- Keep sanitising hands, before and after using any club equipment.
- **KEEP DISTANCE of 1.5m**, always.
