Ground Pearl - especially a problem on Lawn 1

Last Tuesday the Club had a visit from Mr Daryl **Davidson**, Head Grounds Curator at Sydney University where research on the control of Ground Pearl is being undertaken. Daryl spoke about efforts to eradicate the pest on Sydney University playing fields, none of which have so far proved viable. Daryl said that Ground Pearl is a world-wide problem which is proving impossible to effectively and economically control.

Our grounds keeper, Scott Denham, who also attended, is regularly spraying a range of pesticides on our lawns to limit the spread and effect of Ground Pearl.

The general consensus of the meeting was that we will have to live with the problem, and that we are currently using an appropriate control program.
